Safe management measures for Post-CB Phase 2

In addition to the existing safety measures, Canossian School has stepped up with the following:

a) Safe Entry

Parents sending and picking up their children will need to drop off and pick up outside of Gate 1. They are not allowed entry into the school.

Parents who are driving need to stop at designated area, they are not allowed to accompany their children into the school.

Visitors to the school need to access Safe Entry.

b) Designated seating arrangement in class

Desks should be arranged in fixed cluster/exam-style seating with 1 m between students. Group work of up to 5 students during lessons will be allowed while keeping to fixed seating plan.

c) Physical Education (PE) and Unstructured Play

For class-based PE lessons, group activities and small sided games for low-risk, low-contact sport such as badminton, volleyball, basketball will gradually resume, with a limit of five per group and safe management measures.

Mass PE or PE for combined classes should not be carried out until further notice.











