4. PSLE Students (2020)

We bid a fond farewell to our 11 graduands who completed their primary school education with us. We are happy to announce that all of them have been posted to both mainstream and specialized schools (Crest, Spectra and Northlight Schools) to continue with the secondary education. We wish them all the best at their new schools and we look forward to having them visit us and participate at certain school-based events.

5. <u>Safe Management Measures</u> (SMM)

To ensure that schools remain a safe place for teaching and learning, SMMs will continue to be observed when schools reopen, including visual screening and temperature-taking of individuals, observance of high standards of hygiene, and safe distancing between students and staff. Students who are unwell with flu-like symptoms such as fever or cough are reminded to seek medical attention and stay away from school.

While students are not expected to bring in their TraceTogether at the start of school, parents are still expected to collect the tokens for themselves and their children from their constituency's Community Centres/Clubs. For now, schools will continue to use the usual SafeEntry check-in procedures. The tokens will only be required in schools after nationwide distribution is completed.

To maintain our vigilance against spread of the COVID-19 virus, students are encouraged to have a spare mask in their school bags. The masks can be stored in their #CareKitWithLove personalised mask pouches that they designed in November 2020.

6. Strengthening our Home-School Collaboration

Families play a vital role in the development and education of their children. Strong family support contributes to better educational outcomes for the students. In this regard, we have reviewed our processes for developing Individual Learning Plans (ILPs) for students. By taking a more person-centered approach, we intend to engage families in the process as early as possible to jointly establish the annual goals for each student.

To do this, we will begin with dialogue sessions with all families over the next two weeks to share the enhanced process of developing the ILPs. The schedule for the dialogue sessions is as follows:
